Fumed silica is a type of white, tasteless and amorphous powder with small particles size, big specific surface area and high surface activity. It exhibits performance characteristics such as strengthening, thickening, thixotropy, matting, UV-resistance and sterilization and finds wide applications in the areas such as rubber, plastic, coating, painting, ink, adhesive, cosmetics, agriculture and pharmaceuticals.
